- If you know of special circumstances that have impacted this student's academic progress and have the student's permission to mention them, please do so.
- We ask that the signed reference be on letterhead with no electronic signatures.

- **For A Personal Reference:**

- Please state how you know this student, the character of this individual, and if you feel this individual is a good candidate for a scholarship to Western Illinois University and if so, why.
- This letter should be signed but not have an electronic signature and should not come from a family member.
